Oregon Neurosport Physical Therapy and the UO Human Physiology Department are working together to bring on a part-time Physical Therapy Aide starting in Summer 2023 and continuing through the upcoming school year. Oregon Neurosport PT was established in 2004 by Michal Baum PT, CMFT and his wife Victoria Gonzales-Baum with the goal of providing comprehensive physical therapy to both the orthopedic and neurologically involved patients. Michael also previously served as adjunct faculty in the UO HPHY Department, and is committed to mentoring the next generation of physical therapists.

Job Description

PT Aides work closely with PT's and PT Assistant's to ensure proper patient care and carry out the following tasks:

- Participate in patient care directed by their therapist
- Help to administer active/passive manual therapeutic exercise, laser, and ultrasound
- Assist patients dress/undress, put on, fit, remove, or use supportive devices (braces, prosthetics, splints, slings, etc.)
- safely secure patients onto/into therapy equipment (such as the shuttle or stationary bike).
- Assist providers with supplies/assistance/modalities during each appointment
- Maintain, clean and sanitize emptied rooms (including laundry), gym and the rest of the clinic
- Seat patients prior to their appointment
- Maintain inventory of PT clinic supplies
