- PSY 410 Peer Advising and Peer Lab Leader courses are experiential learning courses and only count as Elective credits.
- No more than 4 credits total of PSY 401 (research) or PSY 406 (practicum) can apply to a student's elective credits.
- Minimum GPA of 2.0 in Psychology coursework required to graduate.
